Foundational Apologetics

General Course Description: This course provides an overview of *Foundational Apologetics*.

In this course you will learn about the Biblical foundation and methods for Apologetics, the case for the Existence of God, how we got the Bible and why it can be trusted, how to defend the trinity and tactics for sharing your faith.

Class Expectations: All students are encouraged to attend all 8 classes. Classes 1, 2, 6, 7, & 8 (60%) are required and class evaluations are to be submitted online to receive credit for the class. Online evaluations may be submitted at: www.elpasoba.org/li-evaluations
